I'm not just serving Saugatuck—I'm living alongside you as a neighbor. And if you see me around say "Hi Neighbor."



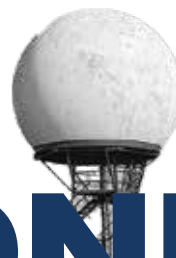
